WHY UGANDA

Uganda's economy experienced strong, broad based growth averaging 10% a year from 2000-2010, compared to a regional average of 5.4%. Current growth is estimated at 6.3%. Agriculture, construction and services accounted for most of the growth, with modest contribution from the manufacturing sector.

With about 45.5 million people (2020) and an annual population growth of 3.7%, food security is scarce and the need for increased agricultural production in Uganda is severe. Uganda is aiming to reach lower-middle-income status. In order to achieve this, a serious reform of the agricultural sector is needed. This offers great opportunities within agriculture for Danish companies. The demand for high quality production and processing equipment, cold-chain facilities, packaging and storing facilities is high, and the need for quality control remains a challenge for Ugandan agricultural exports.
