Food Fraud Cases

Moroccan customs authorities have uncovered a network of certificate forgery in the ports of Tanger-Med and Casablanca. The forged products include spices, food and dried fruits, which were imported as if they were of European origin to benefit from customs benefits.

Approximately 6 000 kg of prosciutto has been seized at a salumificio (cured meat factory) in the province of Bologna, Italy.

A significant quantity of contraband wine has been seized by the police on the PR-323 highway in Brazil. The seizure is part of an operation to combat contraband and smuggling of alcoholic beverages. According to reports, the highway police apprehended 232 bottles of wine that were being transported illegally.

04/04/2025 <u>bonde</u>

A consignment of 500 l of contraband olive oil has been seized by the police on the PR-317 highway in Brazil. The shipment was destined for the city of Londrina.

A significant quantity of untraceable horticultural products has been seized in Catania, Italy. The seizure was carried out after irregularities were detected in the traceability of the products. Fines totaling over EUR 22 000 have been imposed.

06/04/2025 <u>grandangoloagrigento</u>

A Chinese restaurant in Madrid, Spain, has been shut down for serving pigeons as duck. The closure was carried out after irregularities were detected in the kitchen and dead pigeons were found on the premises. The police and health authorities have launched an investigation to determine the cause of the contamination and the possible responsibility of the restaurant owner.

A police operation in the Valle del Cauca region of Colombia has seized 2 630 bottles of adulterated liquor, including aguardiente, whisky, and tequila. The operation took place in the city of Cali, just days before Easter. The police were attacked with stones during the operation. 08/04/2025 elpais elpais

The Singapore Food Authority has seized approximately 1.4 t of illegally imported fruits and vegetables at the Tuas checkpoint. The seizure was carried out after irregularities were detected in the documentation and labelling of the products.

A Vietnamese company, Kera, has been fined and thousands of its products have been destroyed due to a breach of food safety regulations. The company was found to be producing products that did not meet food safety standards, resulting in the destruction of the products and the imposition of a fine.

The Bureau of Customs (BOC) in the Philippines has seized a shipment of refined sugar from Vietnam worth approximately EUR 450 000 due to misdeclaration. The shipment was found to contain refined sugar that was not declared in the customs documents, making it a case of food fraud.

Italian authorities have seized a large quantity of fish and seafood products in the province of Palermo, Italy, due to irregularities in labelling and food safety. The seizure included 4 t of fish and resulted in fines of over EUR 3 000.

Misdescription/ Mislabelling/ Misbranding Thousands of bottles of counterfeit liquor have been discovered in Phnom Penh, Cambodia. The seizure is a significant blow to the illicit liquor trade in the country, and highlights the ongoing problem of food and drink counterfeiting in Cambodia.

A major counterfeit milk scandal has been uncovered in Vietnam, involving the production and distribution of fake milk powder worth approximately EUR 20 million. The scandal has led to the arrest and imprisonment of several individuals, including company directors, and has raised concerns about the country's food safety system.

The police in Thessaloniki, Greece, have dismantled a ring involved in the production and distribution of adulterated olive oil. The operation resulted in the arrest of several individuals and the seizure of large quantities of olive oil.

A food fraud incident occurred in Germany, where a livestock trader falsified labels regarding the rearing of over 1 000 cattle. The trader allegedly deceived consumers by mislabelling the origin and rearing conditions of the animals, compromising the authenticity and quality of the meat. The incident highlights concerns over food safety and transparency in the meat industry. 16/04/2025 t-online bild

Italian police have carried out an operation against illegal fishing in Calabria, Italy, and have seized a large quantity of fish. The operation has resulted in fines totaling EUR 81 000.

A food fraud incident has been detected in Italy, related to Fabio Fazio's chocolate company. The company has been fined EUR 100 000 for a lack of transparency in the labelling of its chocolate products.


