Losses replaced by positive earnings for pig production

Price rises for finishers in March combined with lower feed prices mean that Chinese pig producers are posting positive earnings once again.

According to calculations from China's National Reform and Development Commission (NRDC), Chinese pig producers posted, on average, positive earnings of around 100 yuan per pig in the second week of March.

This comes after Chinese pig producers – as with American pig producers – experienced an extended period of negative earnings.



According to Pig333, which refers to information from Panama's Ministry of Agriculture, China has opened its market to pig meat imports from a pig slaughterhouse in Panama.

According to the authorities in Panama, approval follows a three-year long process. The slaughterhouse is located in the province of Los Santos.



Pig producers lost an average of \$32 per pig in 2023 – but improvements are on the way Calculations from Iowa State University show that American pig producers (with both sows and finishers) lost on average \$32 per pig in 2023.

In July and August 2023, earnings were close to zero, but for the other 10 months of the year, calculations show that producers incurred substantial losses.

2024 also started with losses of \$41 and \$24 per pig in the first two months.

U.S. pig prices and pig futures, however, have risen solidly since January. Increasing futures prices for finishers – combined with lower feed prices – indicate positive earnings for American pig producers for April-October 2024.



Fall in imports of fresh/frozen pig meat in 2023

Ukraine's imports of fresh/frozen pig meat fell sharply in 2023.

The fall was driven by several factors but should primarily be seen as a direct consequence of sharply rising prices for imported pig meat from the EU from spring 2023.

The rising prices for imported pig meat – combined with the squeeze on household incomes – meant that consumption in the Ukrainian market switched from pig meat to less expensive poultry.

With Ukrainian trading statistics as the source, the tables below show Ukraine's imports of fresh/frozen pig meat (product code 0203) compared to the two previous years.

As can be seen, imports of pig meat from the EU took a dive in 2023. However, increasing quantities were imported from Germany as a result of Germany gaining access to the Ukrainian market in 2023.

In contrast to EU countries, increasing quantities of pig meat were imported from Canada in 2023.

According to the latest country report for Ukraine from the USDA, Ukrainian pig meat production fell from 680,000 tonnes in 2022 to 660,000 tonnes in 2023. The USDA expects Ukrainian production to amount to 670,000 tonnes in 2024.

As regards pig meat imports, the USDA expects them to remain unchanged in 2024.



Pig meat exports fell by 19 per cent in 2023
